Welcome CIPS Ontario Members



Again, thank you for being a CIPS Ontario member. We look forward to being to the exciting times ahead for CIPS in the upcoming months!



CIPS' IT Professionalism Week


November 1-5, 2021

Board of Directors - New Member


Welcome - Nicole Heaton


